# **2021 Taiwan Ceramics Awards Competition**

### Purpose

Taiwan Ceramics Awards, organized by New Taipei City Government in the spirit of recognizing role models, creating the future, enriching the present, and is aimed to promote ceramic art and take it to a new level. The Excellence Award, The Creative Award, The Functional Award and The Emerging Award are launched to further vitalize and broaden the horizons of Taiwan's development of ceramics.

#### Awards

- 1. The Excellence Award: The Excellence award is awarded to the people who are long dedicating to ceramic art, making exceptional contributions to the development of ceramic culture in Taiwan such as education, promotion, research, invention, creation, aesthetics, and artistic level.
- 2. The Creative Award: This award encourages the growth of ceramics profession and the innovation of ceramic works that is able to demonstrate the energy and creativity of Taiwan's contemporary ceramics regarding the art statement, skills, forms, ceramic quality, and mixed use of media.
- 3. The Functional Award: This award encourages the functional aspect in ceramic art, which can not only show how art practice evolves from life, but also express the contemporary life aesthetics and the unique features of humanity, such as teaware, tableware, vases, lights, decors, etc.
- 4. The Emerging Award: This awards are to encourage young artists to work on ceramics industry. Through the concept of art, perform skill, expression of style and the realism of ceramics with multiple materials. Show the creativity from new generation of ceramics artists.

## Eligibility:

## 1.The Excellence Award:

- a. Applicant must be a citizen of Republic of China, Taiwan and can only receive this award once in a lifetime.
- b. This award is awarded to those who have provided significant support and influence in the field of

- ceramics, this includes, developmental, educational, promotional, research, innovational, creative, aesthetic, and artistic contributions.
- c. Applicant must have at least one international or domestic solo exhibition, he/she must provide publications and proof of this event.
- 2. The Creative Award: Applicant must be a citizen of the Republic of China, Taiwan or have at least have stayed in the Republic of China for 3 years. The artwork must be made after Oct. 2019 and mainly composed of ceramics. The submitted piece should not have been publicly displayed before, nor has won any awards from international or domestic competitions (including being selected).
- 3. The Functional Award: Applicant must be a citizen of the Republic of China, Taiwan or have at least have stayed in the Republic of China for 3 years. The artwork must be made after Oct. 2019 and mainly composed of ceramics. The submitted piece should not have been publicly displayed before, nor has won any awards from international or domestic competitions (including being selected).
- 4. The Emerging Award: Everyone can only receive the award once. Applicant must be a citizen of the Republic of China, Taiwan or have at least have stayed in the Republic of China, Taiwan for 3 years, and it is necessary to show at least one exhibition experience certificate.

	believes it is necessary for the final selection.

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# Detailed regulations:

- 1. Applicants have accepted all the terms and conditions of this event once you have submitted or have been awarded.
- 2. Regulations for the participation of "The Excellence Award," "The Creative Award," "The Functional Award" and "The Emerging Award":
  - A. The open call of this event are designed for unique artworks made from ceramic artists, artworks

- which can be mass produced are not qualified, please assess the appropriateness of your work.
- B. The online submission process may occur situations where numerous applications are sent to be processed at the same time, which may lead to unexpected problems caused by the server. To ensure your application is successfully completed, an early submission is recommended.
- C. If the submitted artworks have not reached the jury's standards, the jury can carry out a voting procedure to decide whether if the award will be granted.
- D. Primary and final selection outcome will both be announced on our official website, award winners will also be notified by email.
- E. The Grand Prize winners for the "The Creative Award" and the "The Functional Award" will need to further discuss regarding display, whether it is to include the reference work in the exhibition or provide other artworks into the show. The total amount of pieces displayed can be negotiated in the future.
- F. Submitted artworks must not been selected/awarded in any domestic or international competitions. Artwork must be original and is prohibited to violate copyright law, if any violation occurs and is proven to be true, the Museum will disqualify the award recipient and retrieve the award, this includes the prize, trophy, certificate, and anything that is given by the Museum.
- G. All participating artworks that are confirmed to be exhibited cannot be otherwise replaced or withdrawn.
- H. Submission of application form and artwork must be completed and sent within the given timeframe and designated place.

# 3. Artwork transportation and insurance:

- A. The artist will be responsible for the artwork packaging for submission and return, and the insurance for the transportation and delivery process for "The Creative Award." Please make sure your artwork is safely packed, the Museum will not be responsible for any accidents and losses that occurs during the delivery. The Museum will only be responsible of the artwork during the jury process and the exhibition period. The insurance for each artist's set (piece) will not exceed NTD 200,000 (the artist will fully be responsible for artwork that exceeds this amount). Artwork insurance can only apply to the restoration of artwork.
- B. The artist will be responsible for the artwork packaging for submission and return, and the insurance for the transportation and delivery process for "The Functional Award." Please make sure your artwork is safely packed, the Museum will not be responsible for any accidents and losses that occurs during the delivery. The Museum will only be responsible of the artwork during the jury process and the exhibition period. The insurance for each artist's set (piece) will not exceed NTD 60,000 (the artist will fully be responsible for artwork that exceeds this amount). Artwork insurance can only apply to the restoration of artwork.
- C. The artist will be responsible for the artwork packaging for submission and return, and the insurance for the transportation and delivery process for "The Emerging Award." Please make sure your artwork is safely packed, the Museum will not be responsible for any accidents and losses that occurs during the delivery. The Museum will only be responsible of the artwork during the jury process and the exhibition period. The insurance for each artist's set (piece) will not exceed NTD 150,000 (the artist will fully be responsible for artwork that exceeds this amount). Artwork insurance can only apply to the restoration of artwork.
- D. The Museum will be responsible of the artwork once the artwork has been accepted and is in good

condition, the Museum's insurance will only cover the period beginning from the delivery for the final selection to the end of the exhibition. Insurance will exclude conditions such as in the events of force majeure (such as natural disasters etc.), fragile materials, insufficient structures and installation support, experimental artworks, absent of boxing/unboxing procedures indications that cause artwork to be damaged, any above mentioned situation that occurs and is investigated to be true will result in revoking your artwork's insurance.

4. Artwork return: Artworks will be returned to artists after exhibition is taken down, the Museum will announce the time and date on our official website. Please remember to bring your receipt to the Museum in order to collect your work. If you decided to collect your artwork through post or freight, please confirm with your delivery company of the designated time to pick up your artwork, make sure your payment is cash on delivery, all responsibility will be on the artist.

#### 5. Collection:

- A. "The Excellence Award" will need to provide at least 3 pieces of artwork for the Museum's collection panel to choose, only 1 work will be collected and the Museum will receive the ownership and economic rights of the artwork.
- B. The Grand Prize artworks for the "The Creative Award" and "The Functional Award" will be collected and the Museum will receive the ownership and economic rights of the artwork.
- C. "The Emerging Award" will need to provide at least 2 pieces of artwork for the Museum to choose, only 1 work will be collected and the Museum will receive the ownership and economic rights of the artwork.
- 6. The Museum will reserve all the rights to the artworks, images, research, exhibition, photography, publications, and promotion during this event.
- 7. Individual income tax of the prize money will be deducted according to the Income Tax Act of the Republic of China, Taiwan.
- 8. As for unsettled affairs which are not mentioned in the above regulations, the Museum will officially announce further adjustments to the guidelines after an internal review of the subject matter.
